


## About Us


# Transit Location



**The Monorail Project** with the first line connecting the New Administrative capital with East Cairo, extending over 56.5km, containing 22 stations, to be completed over two phases.





- New Administrative Capital (including business districts, government administrative districts, & residential developments)




- Access to multiple key roads including Regional Ring Road, Middle Ring Road and Cairo Suez Road





### Creating an unprecedented landmarks in Egypt


